The words, sentences and paragraphs that are presented have been carefully selected, and graded for different age groups.


Children would find writing in this book enjoyable because, it also helps them acquire new concepts, understand facts, get awestruck about nature and also develop the feeling of patriotism.

The Indian Army has 12.37 lakh personnel comprising of officers and soldiers, having varying levels of educational qualification, training, authority and responsibilities.



Soldiers typically join the Indian Army as a "Sipahi", while the officers join the Army with the rank of "Lieutenant".






