We should always listen to them and keep them happy.

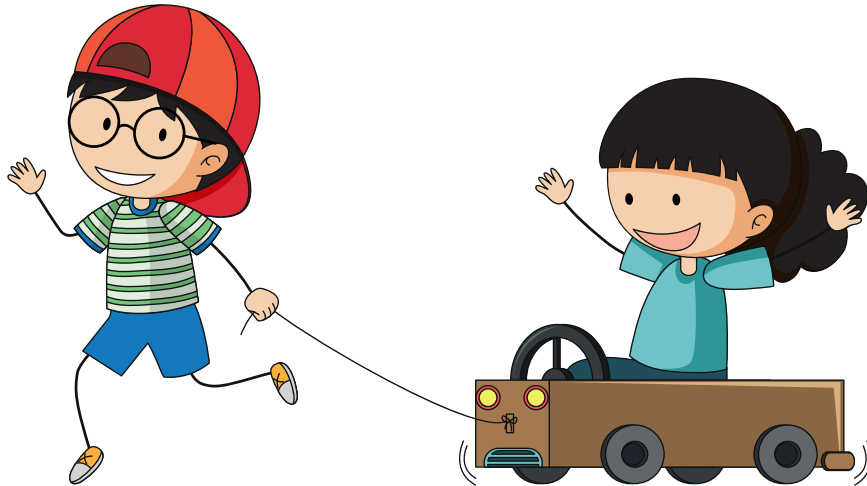

On birthdays and special occasions we should take blessings from our elders by touching their feet.



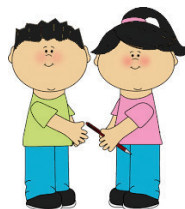
